

2. A copy of the Notice shall be mailed by first class mail to all individuals identified by the parties through inspection of government records as meeting the class definition stated in paragraph 1 above and paragraph 2 of the September 21, 2009 Order Certifying the Class (docket entry 33).

3. The Draft Proposed Web Site Content, also attached hereto, is hereby approved.

4. The parties are authorized to insert any additional dates, contact information, or web site addresses/links as necessary into the approved forms of Notice and Web Site Content attached to this order.

5. Information, whether or not in a document, that is covered by the Privacy Act or other statutes, rules or regulations that limit disclosure of personal information and is furnished by opt-in class members or by defendant or its attorneys in connection with mailing of the Notice, administering the opt-in process, and executing the process of prioritized review by a military records correction board is hereby authorized to be disclosed to Class Counsel, without obtaining prior written consent of the individual to whom such covered information pertains. Such disclosures by defendant or its attorneys shall be deemed authorized by law. *See* 5 U.S.C. § 552a(b)(11).
